LITTER REMOVAL PROCEDURES

- 1. Interested individuals/groups should contact the Gadsden County Public Works Department at 875-8672 for copies of the guidelines and pledge agreement.
- 2. The following areas may be adopted by a sponsoring individual/group: County Roads and Streets
- 3. An original "Gadsden County Adopt-A-Road Litter Agreement", signed by the group coordinator or individual, should be returned at the Public Works Department.
- 4. Upon receipt of the executed pledge, the Public Works Director will order and erect sufficient "Adopt-A-Road" signs at no cost to the sponsoring individual/group.
- 5. Sponsoring individuals/groups are expected to follow good safety practices. Group litter cleanup activities comprising three or more individuals must use traffic control signs and safety vests.
- 6. The Public Works Director will coordinate clean-up efforts with the group and provide litter bags, traffic control signs and safety vests upon request.
- 7. The individual/group will sign for and be responsible for the return of safety equipment. Equipment must be checked out and returned during the following hours: Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- 8. The trash bags should be left under the Adopt-A-Road signs for collection by the Public Works Department upon notification by the group, or the group may dispose of the bags at the end of the clean-up.
- 9. "Adopt-A-Road" Litter Removal Report forms shall be provided and must be completed and returned to the Public Works Department after each clean-up event.
- 10. If a new group coordinator assumes responsibility for the Litter Removal Agreement, either the original coordinator or the new coordinator must contact the Public Works Director in writing to update the contact information for the group. Mailings, e-mails, and telephone contacts with the group will be made to current coordinator listed in Department's records.

SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

The following Safety Recommendations are provided for groups participating in Gadsden County's Adopt-A-Road Litter Removal Program:

- 1. No horseplay of any type will be tolerated.
- 2. No intoxicating liquid, beverage or illegal drugs will be allowed.
- 3. Persons participating should wear gloves, a good quality shoe (no open toe shoes or shower clogs) and light or bright colored protective clothing. No clothing will be allowed that hinders the visibility of the participant.
- 4. An adequate supply of drinking water should be readily available.
- 5. A good pair of sunglasses, cap and sunblock should be considered.
- 6. Carpool to the adopted roadway section to keep the number of cars on the roadside to a minimum. Park off the roadway as far from the edge of the pavement as possible. Parking will not be allowed on any median areas. Keep vehicles on the same side of the roadway as participants.
- 7. Participants should work facing oncoming traffic whenever possible and work on side of the roadway at a time. Do not enter the roadway or its shoulder areas at any time.
- 8. Avoid suspected toxic/hazardous substances; poison ivy, poison oak, noxious weeds; areas where herbicides were applied recently; places where snakes, fire ants or other insects may be located.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

- 1. Every crew should possess an adequate first aid kit.
- 2. Know the route from the work site to the nearest emergency center or hospital in case of serious injury.
- 3. Have transportation immediately available.

Prior to any clean-up operations, the group leader should coordinate their efforts with the Public Works Director, who will provide the required equipment and other special instructions as needed.

ADOPT-A-ROAD LITTER REMOVAL AGREEMENT

THIS ADOPT-A-ROAD LITTER REMOVAL AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT"), is entered into

RECITALS
County Road is a part of the County Road System in Gadsden County,
Florida.
The County has responsibility for operation and maintenance of the County Road System.
The County is authorized to contract with the private sector for performance of its duties.
The legislature has encouraged local organization involvement in specific road litter removal project pursuant to Section 403.4131, Florida Statutes.
The Group wants to adopt a minimum of two miles more or less along the County Road System to remov
litter at County Road, from

AGREEMENT

The parties agree as follows:

1. THE GROUP SHALL:

- A. Be responsible for a minimum of a two-mile segment of a road or combination of shorter roads totaling a minimum of one mile for litter removal and shall remove litter from the designated roadsides at least quarterly.
- B. Perform litter removal in strict accordance with good safety practices and the County's safety procedures and requirements.
- C. Conduct safety and pre-task briefings prior to each litter removal projects.
- D. Remove litter during daylight hours only.
- E. Remove litter during good weather conditions only.
- F. Contact the County's Public Works Department Director to arrange and appropriate litter removal schedule which will not conflict with County mowing schedules.
- G. Refrain from picking up litter at construction or maintenance sites, in tunnels, on bridges or overpasses, or on medians.
- H. Allow participation only by such persons as are determined by the Group to be responsible enough to safely participate in the litter removal activities. Participating youths must be at least 12 years of age and the Group shall provide at least one adult supervisor for every 5 youths aged 12 -1 5 who are participating in the litter removal activity.
- I. Prohibit observation of the activity of persons under the age of 16 who are not official participants.

- J. Wear clothing which will enhance the visibility of participants.
- K. Stock pile litter bags at the "Adopt-A-Road" signs for collection by the County.
- L. Complete a "Littler Removal Report" form for each clean-up activity.

2. THE COUNTY SHALL:

- A. Provide Adopt-A-Road signs to identify the road segment or combinations adopted.
- B. Provide safety vests, traffic control signs and large plastic bags for use by the Group upon request.
- C. Remove stock piled litter bags from adopted highway section.
- D. At the request of the Group, remove certain litter under unusual circumstances (i.e., large, heavy, or hazardous items.)

3. **INDEMNIFICATION**:

The Group covenants and agrees that it will indemnify and hold harmless the County, its officers, and employees from liabilities, damages, losses and costs, including, not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, to the extent caused by negligence, recklessness, or intentional wrongful misconduct of the Group or by a person performing litter removal as part of the Group in the performance of this Agreement. It is specifically agreed between the parties executing this Agreement that it is not intended by any of the provisions of any part of this Agreement to create in the public or any member thereof, a third party beneficiary hereunder, or to authorize anyone not a party to this Agreement to maintain a suit for personal injuries or property damage pursuant to the terms of provisions of this Agreement.

4. AGREEMENT PERIOD:

This Agreement shall remain in effect for a two-year period, beginning on the last date of execution appearing below, and can be renewed upon written request. Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

5. NON-ASSIGNMENT:

This Agreement is non-transferable and non-assignable in whole or in part by the Group without the prior written consent of the County.

6. ACTIVITIES:

This Agreement is for litter removal activities only. No beautification activities are authorized by this Agreement.

7. DETERMINATION OF ADOPTED ROAD SECTION

Any questions, difficulties, or disputes of any nature whatsoever that may arise under or by reason of this Agreement shall be decided by Gadsden County through its Public Works Director, whose decisions upon all claims, questions, and disputes shall be final and conclusive upon the parties hereto.
